

Pathways Community Expectations

As a member of the Pathways @ Commerce community,

I am expected to...

Keep my phone and earbuds in a classroom holder at all times, except during lunch.

Have my uniform on every day with no hood on during class.

Be on time to every class by the four minute marker.

Be respectful and appropriate with my language and in interactions with teachers and peers at all times.

Be seated in my assigned seat immediately upon entering class.

Take out all necessary materials to start my work immediately.

Use a verbal or non-verbal cue to immediately alert an adult if I need help with a problem I can't manage on my own.

If I don't meet these expectations...

For uniform, behavior, and phone infractions, an adult will ask me to self-correct.

If self-correction isn't successful, an adult will remove me from the classroom or hallway to establish a plan of reentry.

If self-correction isn't successful, an adult will assign me to lunch detention for the same day or next day.

For three tardy infractions in a week, an adult will assign me a lunch detention and my family will be contacted.

For skipping infractions, an adult will assign me to a Wednesday detention and my family will be contacted.

For direct disrespect toward a teacher or peer, an adult will assign me a Wednesday detention with community service.

For abusive or threatening language, an adult will remove me from the classroom or hallway and a meeting for a suspension hearing will take place.
