

GRADING POLICY FROM OUR DISTANCE LEARNING LETTER

- If the student was passing with an 70%-100% (A-C) in the course up until the closure, but does not pass or participate in the 4th quarter, then the final course grade will be decreased by 10 % points (1 letter grade)
- If the student was passing with a 60%-69% (D) in the course up until the closure, but does not pass or participate in the 4th quarter, the final course grade will be decreased by 10% and the student will received a grade of “course-in progress” (incomplete) for the year and will have the opportunity to finish the course during the summer
- If the student was passing up until the closure, and participates fully in 4th quarter with high engagement and work quality, then the final grade for the course will increase by an additional 10% points (1 letter grade)
- If the student was failing for the first three quarters and continues to fail in the 4th quarter, then the student will receive a grade of “course-in-progress” (incomplete) for the year and would have the opportunity to finish the course during the summer
- If the student was failing for the first three quarters but passes the 4th quarter, the student will earn a grade of 60%-69% (D) for the year
- For semester courses, for quarter three if students did not complete work, students will earn a 60% (D). Then fourth quarter bullets above apply to semester courses.

PROMOTION

Any student who entered into 3rd quarter with a failing grade, and did not complete any fourth quarter work may be in danger of not being promoted to the next grade in the fall. These specific students will be required to participate in a summer academic program to complete necessary courses and ensure promotion to the following grade.
