- Pathway <u>Dual Enrollment</u> = Earn 20 transferable college credits while enrolled in high school FREE of cost, saving you up to \$20,000. Graduate with high school diploma and a full semester or more of college credits.
- Pathway <u>Career Certificate</u> = Earn an industry recognized certificate to enter your preferred career field immediately following graduation or participate in a paid internship. Save up to \$15,000.
