Concurrent Learning

On May 17th, Commerce will begin a concurrent learning model. Back in February, we invited parents to fill out an online form to indicate whether their scholar would return to school in person.

- If you chose for your scholar to return to school in-person, then your scholar will be in the building every school day from May 17th to June 18th from 7:20-2:30.
- If you chose for your scholar to continue remote learning, then your scholar will stay remote.
- If you did not fill out the survey, then your scholar will continue with remote learning for the remainder of the school year.

Beginning on May 17th, ALL scholars must be logged into LIFE Changers by 7:30 AM.

Breakfast will be provided in the building per usual. Please note that school start time will change for ALL scholars.
